VINTAGE

The 2022 vintage was warmer and drier than average, culminating in a significant 8-day heat surge in early September with temperatures soaring above 110°F. The extreme heat forced Brix to rise and we found ourselves in a hurry to bring in all the fruit as quickly as possible.

VINEYARDS & WINEMAKING

The Foley Johnson 2022 Napa Valley Cabernet is sourced from our own estate vineyards in the heart of Rutherford, Napa Valley. After 18 months in 35% new French and American oak, the wine was bottled on July 30, 2024.

TASTING

Our Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a strong representation of what Napa Valley does best. Cherry, cedar, eucalyptus, blackberry, briar, and black currant waft from the glass. The palate demonstrates the depth of layers that the region is renown for producing - cherry, raspberry, cloves, cinnamon, blackberry, and cola seamlessly integrate forming an elegant body with a long, structured finish. Pair with a juicy beef burger or smoked Gouda cheese.
